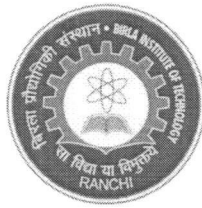

CAMPUS RECRUITMENT PROGRAMME 2016-17

Overview

Total number of recruiters visited till 08/05/2017 is 128 (118 for full time employment & 10 for internship), across different sectors of the industry. Major recruiters ranging from Investment Banks to Consulting and Analytics, Automobile to Heavy Engineering and Infrastructure, IT Product to IT Services companies visited the campus and recruited from the BIT talent pool.

32 recruiters have visited BIT campus for the first time this year and the recruiters who visited last year for the first time have continued this year and the process yielded satisfactory results.

Total numbers of eligible candidate are 1601 including all the campuses & programmes of BIT and a total of 896 offers have been generated till 8th May 2017, several meritorious students have received multiple offers.

The BE students of Mesra Campus, a total of 563 eligible students, received a total of 392 offers. 88% students from BE Computer Science, 85% from BE Electronics & Communication & 92% from BE Information Technology, placed in high-end Consulting & Analytical and IT Product & Services companies. 58% of the BE Mechanical Engineering, 75% of BE Production Engineering and 67% of BE Electrical Engineering students got offers from different Core Engineering companies and high-end Consulting-Analytical & IT companies. Goals for Placement Process 2017-18

- i). The Training & Placement team shall diversify the placements from mass recruiters to core recruiters.
- ii). The students shall be trained by industry experts and in-house faculty members to improve the core fundamentals.
- iii). The students shall be trained to have better human skills.
- iv). A dedicated software for Training & Placement, which shall assist the Division during the Placement Process i e, automated job notification (JNF) for recruiters, invitation of companies, registration of students, automatic feed-back system, information broadcast system, reporting system etc.

Conclusion

- i). The placement process will be continued till May-June end and likely to improve the present placement percentage. It is recorded that about 5-10 Companies are in pipeline and shall be visiting the Campus shortly.
- ii) It is noted that, this year a good number of Companies had changed their hiring process. Instead of placement offers they have hired interns for PPO.
- iii) This year because of Team Training & Placement efforts some good ranking core companies have visited 1st time our campus like, Qualcomm, Infineon, Adobe systems, ITC, UHG, etc.
- iv) It is further noted that the mass recruiters like, Infosys, Cognizant, IBM etc. had very less requirements (below 50% comparing past years), which is expected to decrease further during coming years. This has caused negative impact on hiring process in these companies.
- v) The Recruiters have shared their feedback about the students to brush-up their fundamentals of core subjects as well as to improve their soft and core skills.
